Dear Parents,

We have a very fun, motivating, and educational learning opportunity available to your child! Your 6th, 7th, or 8th grader is invited to join archery class, which will meet once or twice per week, through at least the first of April. We will start off by meeting on Wednesdays by 3:20 pm in the Elementary Gym. We should be done around 4:30.

In order to participate in this program, each student must maintain the same grades as other sports (70% or higher in each class), and have a good attitude/behavior. Students should bring a PowerSchool print out with them to the session. Each student will need to have a signed permission form on file before their first session with a bow in hand.

Students will participate in class which covers some archery history, basics on how we will set up our range, safety issues, whistle commands, and shooting basics. Most students will have participated in this program with Mrs. Miller in prior years, so they will have some experience. The gym is on lock down when it's open as an archery range. Please refrain from coming by and knocking on the doors during range time.
